The Security Policy recognizes that all parties must respect that successful implementation requires that all those who participate in any activity of the company, respect the differences of ethnicity and gender that will occur throughout the life of the operations.

- Formal community grievance mechanism
- Protection of assets and staff
- Proper involvement with national security entities
